



FEES FOR POST-PUBLICATION SERVICES

Fee ranges listed below are current for Jan 2024 – Dec 2024

If you are interested in Print on Demand (POD) and/or ebook conversion/distribution for your book, we can provide a separate quote for these post-publication services after all the initial steps in your self-publishing project have been finalised.

Print on Demand (POD) account set-up fee

Fee ranges between **\$275 – \$375**

- Initial 20–30 minute phone consultation to mentor client through Print on Demand set-up process
- Set up an author account on Amazon KDP Print and/or IngramSpark and upload interior pages and book cover PDF files in preparation for Print on Demand (POD) book sales
- Modify original cover file so that it complies with Amazon's and/or IngramSpark's specified book trim requirements
- Fill in and submit taxation form online on client's behalf
- Insert client's bank account details (including SWIFT code) for POD sales royalties
- Input book metadata (i.e. title, description, POD cover specs, author details/bio, ISBN details, RRP for printed book sales, BISAC subject headings and relevant keyword phrases)
- Undertake digital proofing process to approve client's POD book title for online sales

Ebook conversion services fee

Fee ranges between **\$400 – \$950**

- Manually convert typeset book to EPUB file (reflowable text format) via HTML and CSS coding
- Create front cover JPG image at the correct pixel/resolution dimensions for ebook title page

Ebook account set-up/distribution fee

Fee ranges between **\$195 – \$295**

- Upload EPUB file and ebook cover image to Amazon Kindle Direct Publishing (KDP) account, plus set up author account on Draft2Digital ebook aggregator service for Apple Books, Kobo, Barnes & Noble (Nook) etc and upload EPUB file and ebook cover image
- Fill in and submit taxation form online on client's behalf
- Insert client's bank account details (including SWIFT code) for ebook sales royalties
- Input book metadata (i.e. title, description, author details, ISBN details, RRP for ebook sales, BISAC subject headings and relevant keyword phrases)
